STATE HEALTH OFFICER ORDER FOR TESTING FOR 2019-nCoV/COVID-19 AS A DISEASE CONTROL MEASURES TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF 2019-nCoV/COVID-19 PURSUANT TO NORTH DAKOTA CENTURY CODE § 23-01-05(12)

SECTION A: SUBJECT PERSONS

ALL PERSONS RESIDING IN THE FIRST DISTRICT HEALTH UNIT LOCATED IN THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA. THE FIRST DISTRICT HEALTH UNIT INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING COUNTIES: BOTTINEAU; BURKE; MCHENRY; MCLEAN; RENVILLE; SHERIDAN; AND WARD.

SECTION B: FINDINGS

- 1. The Director General of the World Health Organization has declared that the 2019nCoV/COVID-19 constitutes a Public Health Emergency of International Concern. The Secretary of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has declared that 2019nCoV/COVID-19 constitutes a public health emergency.
- 2. On March 13, 2020, President Donald Trump issued a declaration of national emergency due to the growing 2019-nCoV/COVID-19 crisis in the United States.
- 3. On March 13, 2020, Governor Doug Burgum declared a state of emergency in response to the public health crisis resulting from 2019-nCoV/COVID-19; Executive Order 2020-03 activated the State Emergency Operation Plan (SEOP), implementing appropriate response and recovery actions and future mitigation measures.
- 4. Both travel related cases and community contact transmission of 2019-nCoV/COVID-19 have been documented in North Dakota and are expected to continue.
- Delay in imposing this Order would significantly jeopardize the ability of the Department of Health to prevent or limit the transmission of 2019-nCoV/COVID-19, a contagious disease, to others.
- Increased transmission poses a substantial threat to the residents who are living in a congregate setting and have an increased risk of developing complication related to 2019nCoV/COVID-19, public health, and the health care system.
- 7. A written order for testing for 2019-nCoV/COVID-19 is a disease control measure and is authorized pursuant to N.D.C.C. 23-01-05(12).
- 8. Written orders issued pursuant to N.D.C.C. 23-01-05(12) shall have the same effect as a physician's standing medical order.

SECTION C: REQUIREMENTS

1. Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) testing for 2019-nCoV/COVID-19 is authorized for all subject persons, as defined by SECTION A.

- 2. First District Health Unit staff will conduct all testing for 2019-nCoV/COVID-19 authorized by this Order.
- 3. Testing for 2019-nCoV/COVID-19 as authorized by this Order is effective immediately and shall remain in effect for the duration of the declared emergency or until revoked.
