In the event of a pregnancy, an RSV immunization is recommended during pregnancy at least 14 days before delivery.

You may require additional vaccines if you are at an increased risk for certain diseases. Talk to your health care provider about what vacciens are right for you.

*Hep A 2-dose series with a minimum of 6 months between doses between ages 12-23 months

Meningococcal - minimum age of 2 months, routine vaccination at 11-12 Years (2-dose series) and 16 years

*HPV - Routinely recommended at 11-12 years, but can start at 9 years; 2- or 3-dose series depending on age at initial vaccination

*Influenza vaccination recommended annually

*COVID-19 vaccine recommended annually
